- I. Call to Order:
 Peri Swenson of Kinney Management called the Annual Meeting to order at 6:30 PM.
- II. Welcoming Remarks and Introductions: Peri Swenson gave welcoming remarks and introduced Chris Barr – Tartesso Board Member, Patrick HagEstad – City of Buckeye District 4 Councilmember, Lieutenant Bruce Root – Buckeye Police Department, Mike Peterson – Legends Landscape and the Tartesso Advisory Committee.

Chris Barr announced that there would be no increase to the 2019 monthly assessment, it will remain at \$84.70. We will continue to watch the budget closely to include any water rate changes with the City of Buckeye.

- Councilmember Patrick HagEstad spoke of his first year in service, current improvements planned for Buckeye and answered questions from members.

Open Discussion resulted in questions/concerns on construction noise and trash, ATV traffic on the streets and in the surrounding desert area, lighting outages at palm trees and other common areas, watering of open emitters in landscape, and condition of Thomas Road for cleanup of trash and debris.
